Free Medical Consultation Camp in Annamangalam Village, Perambalur District – 13.10.2024

A free medical consultation camp was held at Annamangalam Higher Secondary School in Veppanthattai taluk of Perambalur district, organized by Priyam Hospital, the Victory Lions Club and the Puthiya Thalaimurai Foundation on 13.10.2024.

Dr. Vivek, the Chief Doctor of Priyam Hospital and Dr. Mano Anand, Plastic Surgeon participated in the camp, offering consultations on issues related to bone and joint disorders, back and neck pain, joint replacement surgeries, modern minimally invasive surgical techniques, burns, congenital defects in children, orthopedic surgeries,



and treatment options for complex fractures. The camp provided free bone density tests and blood tests. More than $100\,\mathrm{g}\,$ eneral peoples participated in the medical camp.
